This includes program information, preparing and monitoring program budgets and schedules, preparing reports, processing payments, tracking project progress and activity costs. Public Facilities and Improvements: Sidewalks	The purpose of the project is to provide sidewalk infrastructure in CDBG eligible census tracts/block groups throughout the City of Fort Worth. The project will contribute significantly to the creation of a pedestrian friendly environment and will enhance safety by separating pedestrians from vehicular traffic. The City will install approximately 19.01 linear miles of sidewalk in CDBG eligible areas. The construction contract is expected to be executed by November, 2009 and should be completed within 36 months from the date of grant agreement execution. Sidewalk infrastructure in CDBG eligible neighborhoods throughout the City of Fort Worth will contribute significantly to the creation of a pedestrian friendly environment and will separate pedestrians from vehicular traffic. Sidewalk infrastructure will take place throughout the City of Fort Worth in Council Districts 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 and 9; all in CDBG eligible neighborhoods.
